

PREFACE

The Eighth Texas-Mexico Conference on Astrophysics “Energetics of Cosmic Plasmas” was held in Mexico City on October 31 and November 1 & 2, 2002. This conference series has brought together astronomers from Mexico, Texas and other areas of the world and has provided very fruitful scientific exchange among participants and institutions. In this occasion there were more than 70 participants from more than 15 institutions of 5 different countries.

The scientific program of the meeting comprised 22 invited talks and more than 30 contributed papers (oral and poster presentations).
