

ABSTRACT ONLYTHE 0TH MERIDIAN OF BUENOS AIRESD. D. Carpintero^{1,2} and R. B. Orellana^{1,2}

The Buenos Aires meridian was used at the end of the 19th century as a reference origin to establish limits between the provinces and the then national territories. However, the exact position that materialized this meridian could never be established, with the consequent uncertainty in the limits that depended on it. In this work, we determine for the first time the exact position of the meridian of the city of Buenos Aires.

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
